It's hard to believe it's already February, which means it's time for our Valentine's Mega Meat/Seafood raffle! Our Valentine Raffle starts at noon on February 8, 2025, so come early to get your seat. Overflow parking is available across the street at Old National Bank. There are 232 packages, so there's a chance you could win multiple packages.

House Rules: Sellers will be assigned to sections and only sell to patrons in their sections. Don't chase them down. You must be seated to buy tickets, and you can only buy for yourself. Sellers will start selling wherever they left off on their last sale. The most important rule is to be respectful, as they're trying their best.

The E-tabs have been fully upgraded to fall with the State of Minnesota's new rules. I've seen some good payouts for our customers, so I'm always happy for them!

We have three cash raffles weekly here at Post 39.

Wednesday is a \$5.00 raffle ticket (200 tickets), "Hump Day," which pays out \$700.00.

Friday is a \$1.00 raffle ticket (800 tickets), "Lucky Buck," which pays out \$500.00.

Sunday is a \$5.00 raffle ticket (400 tickets), "Sunday-Funday," which pays out \$1000.00.

We have 4 \$1 boxes, 3 \$2 boxes, a \$5 box, and 12 Etabs with Booty Bingo.

Remember, we have two bingo sessions each week. Tuesday's session starts at 6 p.m., and Saturdays' session starts at 4 p.m. We have 10 games, three each session, with the last one being a \$1,000 coverall, with a \$200 consolation prize if bingo is not reached in the pre-determined number of balls. One of the Post's most visible means of showing its commitment to Veterans and the community is through the Honor Guard. With an ever-increasing schedule of events, they are looking to recruit new members from the Post membership. The only qualifications are that they are a Post 39, SAL, or Auxiliary member and have been for at least one year.



The post provides uniforms, and Honor Guard members receive a \$50 per day stipend when participating in events. The group meets on the third Thursday of the month at 6 p.m., except in July.

The Honor Guard performs 20 to 30 events a year. These include serving as casket guards, folding and presenting the flag, and playing taps at veterans' funerals and local community events, including parades and dedications. The two busiest days for the group are Memorial Day, with events at local cemeteries, and Veteran's Day, with events at local schools or nursing homes.

So, if you want to get more involved in the Post and serve other veterans and the community, consider joining the Post 39 Honor Guard. Application forms are available at the Post.
