Although the Thursday night seafood raffles and virtual racing have concluded for now, your patronage is vital in helping us stay open, support Veterans and Youth Programs, and maintain a welcoming space for Veterans and community members. We look forward to seeing you soon and appreciate your continued support.

Friday Night Meat Raffles at 4:00 p.m., with tickets starting at \$1.00. We will be raffling off roughly 14 packages each week. Virtual Racing starts at 4:00 p.m. during the meat raffle. Tickets are \$1.00 each, with multiple payouts ranging from \$50 to \$500.00.

Don't forget we have two bingo sessions each week. Tuesday's session starts at 6 p.m., and on Saturdays, we start at 4 p.m. We have 10 games 3 each session, with the last one being a \$1,000 coverall, with a \$200 consolation prize if bingo is not reached in the pre-determined number of balls.

We have three cash raffles weekly here at Post 39.
